HIGH SCHOOL IDOL RULES AND REGULATIONS 2016

- The competition will be held at Superior CVI and shall be under the working management of the Superior CVI Music Department. Any questions not dealt with in these rules shall be referred to the above whose decisions on all such matters shall be final and binding to all concerned.
- The entry form must reach the Superior CVI Music Department on or before Friday, April 8th The number of entries are limited. There will be a Grade 7/8, Open, Original and Duet Class.
- Auditions are on Friday, April 15th, 7pm and the Finals are on Saturday, April 16th, 7pm.
- Elementary students enter the Grade 7/8 Class. High School students may enter the Original Class or Duet Class, but not both. And the Open Class 1 or Open Class 2, but not both.
- Any style of singing is eligible in the Grade 7/8 Class, Open, Original or Duet Song Class.
- In the Original Class, the singer must be the writer or co-writer of the lyrics and/or music.
- In the Duet Class, one of the singers must be a High School student.
- Entries must be fully completed on the Official Entry Form which is available at;

hsidol.lakeheadschools.ca

- The singer (soloist) must currently be a full or part-time student in Grades 7 to 12.
- A singer may accompany him/herself on piano or acoustic guitar or have an accompanist(s).
- Open Class and Duet singers may use live accompaniment or disc, but not both.
- Accompaniment combinations are as follows: piano only, acoustic guitar only, piano and acoustic guitar or two acoustic guitars. One guitar may be a bass, either upright or electric. The Open 1 and Grade 7/8 Class may use an accompaniment disc that <u>does not</u> include a lead vocal track. Background or harmony vocals on the disc are permitted.
- Duet discs must not contain any backing vocal tracks.
- Piano or guitar accompanists do not have to be students, however, it is encouraged.
- A Techniques electric piano is supplied. Acoustic guitars are not supplied.
- A sound technician will be used for each act. Guitars will be plugged in or will use a pick-up.
- In the Grade 7/8, Open 1 & 2 and Duet Class 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners will receive prizes.
- The Original Class winner receives a free recording session of their winning song.
- The judges will provide feedback to singers at the auditions and the decision will be final.
- Singers may change their song entry selection at any time before the April 15th auditions.
- The Superior CVI Music Department reserves the right to broadcast and/or publish any part of the High School Idol competition and its registered participants without any prior written and/or verbal permission, and without compensation to any party on/in any media.
- Competitors will be emailed upon receipt of the entry form and the \$15.00 registration fee.
